

Sabre Sailing Association of Tasmania Inc. Notice of Race Eighty Options Tasmanian State Titles 2nd to 4th April 2010





The regatta is organized and hosted by the Port Esperance Sailing Club, in conjunction with the Sabre Sailing Association of Tasmania Inc.

The racing will be held on Port Esperance in the vicinity of Port Esperance Sailing Club, Dover, Tasmania.

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the ISAF 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the specific regulations of the YA, the class rules of the Sabre Sailing Association of Australia Inc, (except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions) and by the Sailing Instructions.

The regatta is classified as a Category A event in accordance with RRS 79 and Appendix 1 Regulations 20 of the RRS.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of the Sabre class that comply with the class rules of the Sabre Sailing Association of Australia Inc and whose crew are current financial members of their related State Sabre Association. Competitors must also be current financial members of a club affiliated with a State Yachting Association and be members of Yachting Australia (YA).
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter on the attached Entry Form, which shall be lodged to Chris Keil, Secretary, Sabre Sailing Association of TAS, 27 Honolulu St. Midway Point, TAS, 7171 Boats should confirm their entry with the Port Esperance Sailing Club by completing an online form at www.eightyoptions.com.au/regatta_entry
- 2.3 Entries will be accepted, at the Port Esperance Sailing Club from 1200 to 1230 hours, Friday 2 April 2010, accompanied by the appropriate entry fee.
- 2.4 Eligibility for various divisions within the regatta shall be governed by the competitors' age as at 4 April 2010.

3 FEES

3.1 A non-refundable entry fee of \$40 is payable to the Sabre Sailing Association of TAS Inc.

4.4 Functions

Will be held in conjunction with the Huon Tasmanian Salmon Port Esperance Regatta. A free yachties' sausage sizzle will be held on Friday night with cook-your-own BBQ (steak, chicken, salmon) plus salad on Saturday and Sunday nights. Bands will perform at the club on Saturday and Sunday nights and the bar will be open.

5 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall exhibit an "A" class measurement certificate and in addition the following shall apply:

- 5.1 All competitors shall use only one sail, one centerboard and one rudder blade during the regatta.
- 5.2 Prior to 2 April 2010 or as agreed with the State Measurer, each competitor must ensure that the sail, centerboard and rudder blade to be used in the regatta has been measured and endorsed by the State Measurer for season 2010.
- 5.3 The class measurer, or appropriate delegate, may conduct random measurement checks on boats and equipment before, during and after the regatta at the discretion of the Race Committee or Sabre Association of Tasmania Inc.
- 5.4 Damaged equipment may be replaced on written request to and approval by the race committee.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available from the Port Esperance Sailing Club before the briefing on Friday 2 April 2010 and online at www.eightyoptions.com.au/regatta_entry .

7 RACING AREA

The racing area will be on the waters of Port Esperance, Dover, Tasmania.

8 COURSES

The course shall be triangular in shape as described in the sailing instructions.

9 SCORING

The Low Point scoring system, Appendix A.4.1 will apply. Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10 SUPPORT BOATS

Team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall not approach within 100 metres of any boats that are racing without prior approval of the Race Committee. Failure to comply may result in the disqualification of all competitors associated with the infringement.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmission while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones.

12 INSURANCE

- 12.1 All boats competing in this regatta shall have third party insurance cover of not less than AUD \$5,000,000.
- 12.2 All owners/competitors who sign the entry form are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover.
- 12.3 Competitors may be required to produce evidence of such insurance.
- 12.4 Any competitor not holding this cover shall withdraw their entry.

13 PRIZES

Prizes may be awarded as follows:

CATEGORY	PRIZE
Open	1st to 3rd place
Junior Champion (17 years & under)	1st place
B & C Divisions (where applicable)	1st place

Allocation of prizes in all categories and the allocation of 2nd and 3rd prizes remains at the discretion of the Sabre Sailing Association of Tasmania Inc. and is dependent on the number of boats racing in each category. Presentation will occur on Sunday 4 April 2010 at the Huon Tasmanian Salmon Port Esperance Regatta presentation ceremony.

14 DISCLAIMER

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The organizing authority and all parties involved in the events organization accept no liability for any loss, damage, death or injury which may occur to property or persons, both ashore and afloat, as a consequence of participation in this event. The establishment of the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions in no way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibility of a competitor being solely and entirely responsible for the management of a yacht that he/she is sailing.
