Hobart Summer Festival Many events taking place right on the waterfront. Features the Taste of Tasmania food and wine festival.

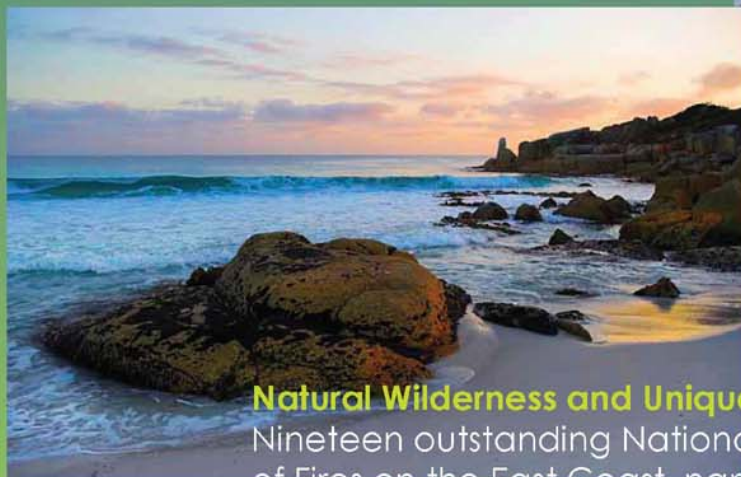
