

DIAGRAM 1 – WALLAROO SOUTH AUSTRALIA




DIAGRAM 2 - WALLAROO SAILING CLUB - HERITAGE DRIVE




DIAGRAM 3 - RACE AREA - WALLAROO BAY, SOUTH AUSTRALIA
