

Sabre Sailing Association of Australia Inc. Notice of Race The 28th National Sabre Championships 28th December 2005 to 4th January 2006



These titles are organized under the authority of the Lindisfarne Sailing Club, in conjunction with the Sabre Sailing Association of Tasmania Inc. on behalf of the Sabre Sailing Association of Australia Inc.

The racing will be held on the Derwent River, Hobart, Tasmania.

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the ISAF 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the specific regulations of the AYF, the class rules of the Sabre Sailing Association of Australia Inc, (except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions) and by the Sailing Instructions.

The regatta is classified as a Category A event in accordance with RRS 79 and Appendix 1 Regulations 20 of the RRS.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of the Sabre class that comply with the class rules of the Sabre Sailing Association of Australia Inc and whose crew are current financial members of their related State Sabre Association. Competitors must also be current financial members of a club affiliated with a State Yachting Association and be members of Yachting Australia (YA).
- Eligible boats may enter on the attached Entry Form, which shall be lodged with payment to Andrew Bradshaw, Sailing Secretary, Sabre Sailing Association of TAS, 7 First Avenue, Dodges Ferry, TAS, 7173 by 30th November 2005.
- 2.3 Eligibility for various divisions within the regatta shall be governed by the competitors' age as at 31st December 2005.

3 FEES

- 3.1 A non-refundable entry fee of \$90 is payable to the Sabre Sailing Association of TAS Inc. by 30th November 2005.
- 3.2 A non-refundable late entry fee of \$25 is payable to the Sabre Sailing Association of TAS Inc. in addition to the entry fee for those yachts that enter after 30th November 2005.

4.4 Schedule of Races

The Series will consist of ten heats comprising both large and small triangular courses. No warning signal will be made after 1400 hours on last day of the regatta.

5 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall exhibit an "A" class measurement certificate and in addition the following shall apply:

- 5.1 All competitors must present one sail, one centerboard and one rudder blade for inspection by the class measurer prior to the completion of registration.
- 5.2 All competitors shall use only the registered equipment during the regatta.
- 5.3 The class measurer, or appropriate delegate, may conduct random measurement checks on boats and equipment before, during and after the regatta at the discretion of the Race Committee or Sabre Association of TAS Inc.
- 5.4 Damaged equipment may be replaced on written request to and approval by the race committee.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available from Lindisfarne Sailing Club during registration on Tuesday 27th and Wednesday 28th December 2005.

7 REGATTA SITE & RACING AREA

The racing area will be shown in 'Attachment A".

8 COURSES

The course shall be triangular in shape as described in the sailing instructions.

9 SCORING

The Low Point scoring system, Appendix A.4.1 will apply. Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10 SUPPORT BOATS

Team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall not approach within 100 metres of boats that are racing from the time of the preparatory signal and until the time all boats have finished or the Race Committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment. Failure to comply may result in the disqualification of all competitors associated with the infringement. Support boats must register with the Race Committee.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmission while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones.

12 INSURANCE

- 12.1 All boats competing in this regatta shall have third party insurance cover of not less than AUD \$5,000,000.
- 12.2 All owners/competitors who sign the entry form are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover.
- 12.3 Competitors may be required to produce evidence of such insurance.
- 12.4 Any competitor not holding this cover shall withdraw their entry.

13 PRIZES

Prizes may be awarded as follows:

Ladies Champion	1st place
Junior Champion (17 years & under)	1st place
Seniors Champion (18 - 39 years)	1 st place
Masters Champion (40 - 49 years)	1st place
Grand masters Champion (50 - 59 years)	1 st place
Veterans Champion (60+ years)	1st place
B, C & D Divisions (where applicable)	1 st place

Allocation of prizes in all categories and the allocation of 2nd and 3rd prizes remains at the discretion of the Sabre Sailing Association of Tasmania Inc. and is dependent on the number of boats racing in each category.

14 DISCLAIMER

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The organizing authority and all parties involved in the events organization accept no liability for any loss, damage, death or injury which may occur to property or persons, both ashore and afloat, as a consequence of participation in this event. The establishment of the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions in no way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibility of a competitor being solely and entirely responsible for the management of a yacht that he/she is sailing.


