Clause Addition – 6.2

- 6.2 To be eligible for a podium position in the Sabre States (1st, 2nd or 3rd) the sailor must satisfy that they are a regular, or intend to be a regular, participant in the Sabre Class. The Sabre Association of WA has the final decision on what constitutes a “regular, or intend to be a regular, participant.”

Amendment to Sailing Instructions Notice.: 1

Clause Amendment 2.1

2.1 Original Clause

The regatta is open to boats of the Sabre class that comply with the class rules of the Sabre Sailing Association of Australia Inc and whose crew is a current financial member of the Sabre Sailing Association Western Australia Inc. Competitors must also be current financial members of a club affiliated with a State or National Yachting Association.

2.1 Amended Clause

The regatta is open to boats of the Sabre class that comply with the class rules of the Sabre Sailing Association of Australia Inc and whose crew is a current financial member of **any** Sabre Sailing Association in **Australia**. Competitors must also be current financial members of a club affiliated with a State or National Yachting Association.

Clause Addition – 4.1

- 4.1 There will be a competitors briefing held at 9.00am on the 22nd November at TCYC and on the 29th November 2015 at NYC. Specific location of the briefing will be advised on the day.

Clause Addition - 17.4

- 17.4 A maximum of 8 races are scheduled, of which 4 races shall be completed to constitute a series. A boat's series score will be the total of her 8 best race scores excluding her two worst scores.

Discard system is as follows –

- Race 1 – no discards
- Race 2 – no discards
- Race 3 – no discards
- Race 4 – no discards
- Race 5 – 1 discard
- Race 6 – 1 discard
- Race 7 – 2 discards
- Race 8 – 2 discards

Clause Amendment 22.2

22.2 Original Clause

To be eligible for a podium position in the Sabre States (1st, 2nd or 3rd) the sailor must satisfy that they are a regular, or intend to be a regular, participant in the Sabre Class at a Western Australia Club Level, the Sabre Association of WA has the final decision on what constitutes a “regular, or an intend to be a regular, participant.”

22.2 Amended Clause
